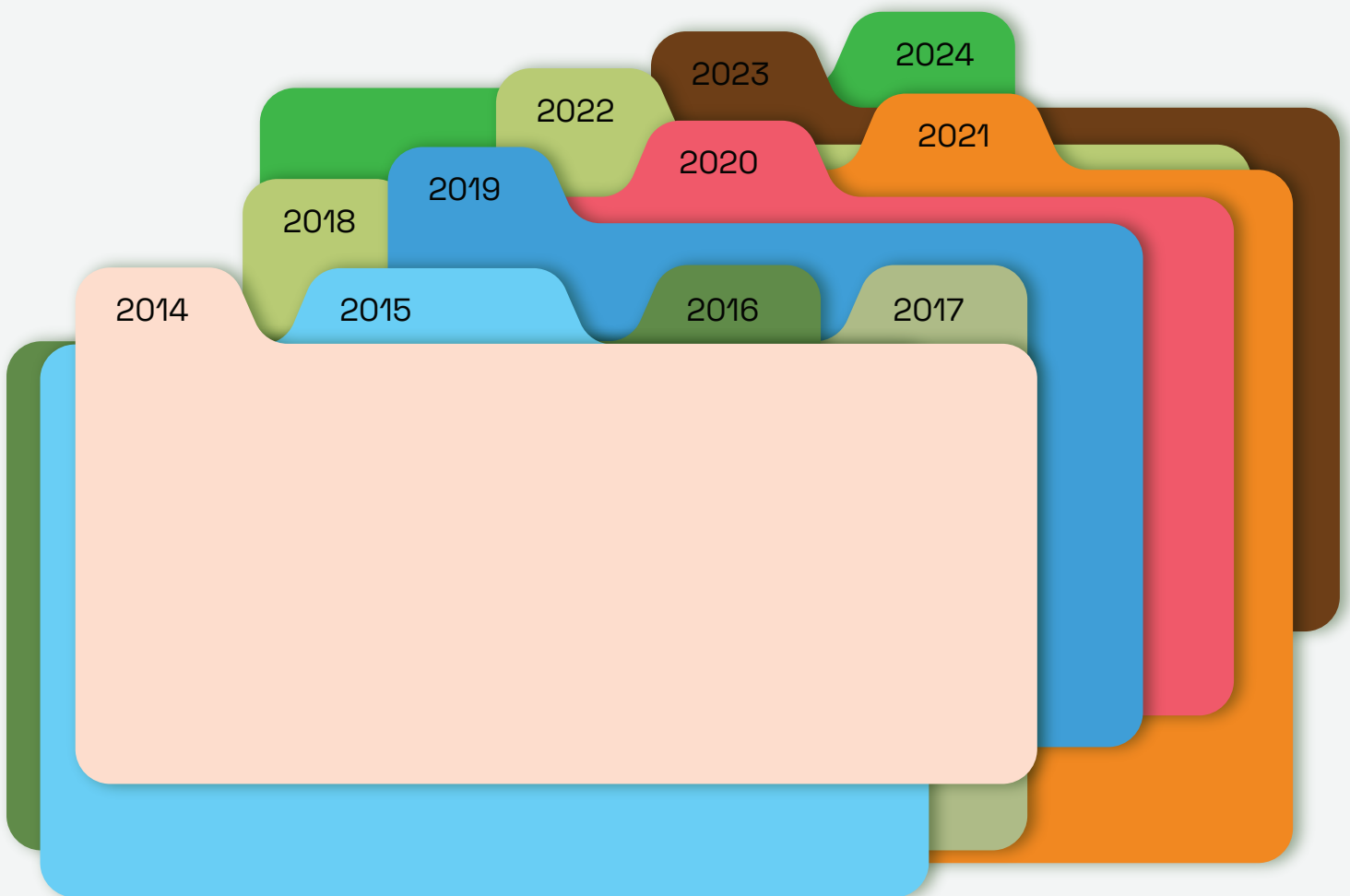
Collaboration In The Region
